WEEE Statement

Directive 2012/19/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4th July 2012 lays down measures to protect the environment and human health by preventing or reducing the adverse impacts of the generation and management of waste from electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE).

The policy of Sonifex Ltd is to comply with all applicable laws of all jurisdications having authority over Sonifex's business, including the WEEE directive. Accordingly, Sonifex has implemented a rigourous program designed to ensure compliance of its products with the WEEE directive. - Keeping accurate records of Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE) Sonifex has placed onto the market.
- Provide product recycling information to end users to enable safe and effective treatment at the end of a product's life.
